Cheerfully: God loves a cheerful giver. Paul tells us that God loves a joyful and big-hearted response to all the love He lavished on us.

Thoughtfully: Each person should give what they have decided in their heart to give, having considered carefully their personal responsibilities.

Regular Giving is needed to support our ministry and mission in the local community and beyond. Regular giving is also needed to maintain our beautiful listed building with its extensive halls and community facilities.

What Other Ways Can I Give?

Volunteer your time:
