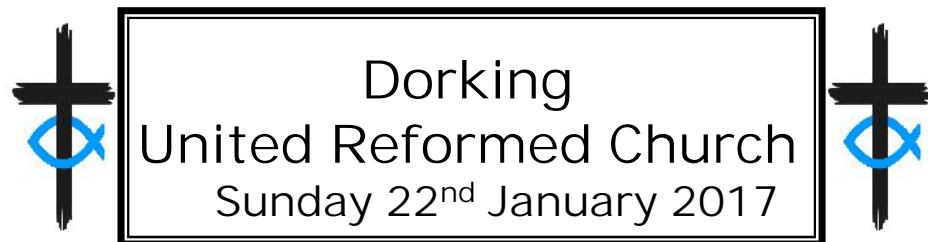


Living Jesus' love
