



‘**Thy Kingdom Come**’ is a global prayer movement, which invites Christians around the world to pray for 9 days between Ascension and Pentecost - praying for people to come to know Jesus Christ and the coming of the Holy Spirit. What started out as an invitation from the Archbishops of Canterbury and York in 2016 to the Church of England, has grown into an international and ecumenical call to prayer. The wave of prayer culminates with celebration events, on Pentecost, around the country.
